



## Free CO<sub>2</sub> compensation for sending your mailings with Quickmail

### Our contribution to climate protection

We have always been committed to minimizing emissions in our deliveries and to steadily reducing CO<sub>2</sub> and other greenhouse gas emissions. We serve over 80% of all households on foot or by bicycle. Since 2015, we have been offsetting all CO<sub>2</sub> emissions generated by the transport and delivery of shipments that cannot be avoided in effective climate protection projects.

CO<sub>2</sub> compensation is already included in our services by default and at no surcharge.

### The project

Through our carbon offset partner myclimate, we support the CommuniTree Carbon Program, a community-based reforestation project in Nicaragua. In this project, small farming families work together to reforest unused parts of their land. Thanks to better use of space and sustainable use of resources, the forest area is increased and the quality of life of the community's inhabitants is improved.

As a private postal service provider, we believe not only in the future of mailboxes, but also in paper as a physical medium. Printed and delivered advertising mail creates jobs in our region. That is why paper and the protection of the ecosystems that produce this raw material are particularly important to us.

For this reason, we have chosen a forest conservation project. The project has already been running since 2010 and pays tribute to eleven Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). We would like to particularly highlight the development in two goals since the start of the project in 2010:



6 million US dollars were paid to over 1,300 farming families.



On more than 6,000 hectares 10 million native trees were planted. That amounts to around 11,500 football fields.

Quickmail was founded in August 2009 and delivers addressed letters, mailings, catalogues and magazines weighing over 50 g.

Quickmail currently employs 121 full-time staff and 3,200 part-time employees (delivery staff).

Converted to full-time positions, this corresponds to around 456 employees.

Quickmail's customers come from the mail order, retail, publishing, fundraising, automotive, education and tourism sectors.

Since June 2019, Quickmail has been offering customers from the mail-order and retail trade evening delivery and same-day delivery of parcels in Switzerland at affordable prices through Quickpac AG. Quickpac is the first parcel service provider in Europe to use electric cars for the delivery of parcels throughout the country. Quickpac currently reaches around 2.0 million Swiss households (71.0 % of all households in German-speaking Switzerland).

With round about 300 electric cars, Quickpac operates one of the largest electric car fleets in Switzerland.
